1. Australian Stock Horse and Lady Rider.

One horse, one rider per ASHLA class.

Hi Point & Runner Up Hi Point ASHLA

2. First Season Australian Stock Horse and Lady Rider.

Rider not to have competed in an ASHLA Class at any time prior to 1st January, 2015. One horse, one rider per ASHLA class.

Hi Point & Runner up First season ASHLA Rider.

3. Led Australian Stock Horse 5 years and over.

Only Led ASH events to be included. No open led Hack or Galloway, other breeds. Progeny pairs or sire pairs etc. Horse to have been led by ASHLA member

Hi Point & Runner up High Point Led ASH

4. Led Junior Australian Stock Horse Under 5yrs

Only Led ASH events to be included. No open Led Hack or Galloway, other breeds, Progeny pairs of sire pairs etc. Horse to have been led by ASHLA member.

5. Campdrafting. Open Novice, Ladies, Progressive, Maiden, Ladies Associated, (No teams, Challenges, maturity) Horse to have been ridden by ASHLA member.

Hi Point & Runner Up High Point Campdraft

6. Dressage. Advanced or higher, Medium, Elementary, Novice, Preliminary. (No one, two or three day events or combined training). Horse to have been ridden by ASHLA member.

Hi Point & Runner Up Hi point dressage Horse.

7. Hacking. Open Hack, ASH Hack, Novice Hack, Intermediate Hack, Ladies Hack, Best Educated hack, Pleasure hack, Stallion Hack (Not rider classes). Horse to have been ridden by ASHLA member.

Hi Point & Runner Up High Point Hack.

8. Performance. Working ASH, Station Horse, Ridden ASH, Overall Versatility & Challenge, Reining Patterns, Tent Pegging, Polocrosse, Sporting events, Showjumping, Eventing and any other events deemed suitable to fit into this category. Horse to have been ridden by ASHLA member.

Hi Point & Runner up High Point Performance Horse.

9. Overall High Point. Points to be calculated from a minimum of 4 categories listed above.

Hi Point Overall Competitor.

10. Junior Rider Overall High Point. Points to be calculated from all categories where point have been gained.

Hi Point Overall Junior Rider.

11. HRCav Section. Official HRCav Classes. A copy of Performance cards to be provided with point score sheet. This section is not eligible for overall high point as it is a restricted class.

Hi Point & Runner Up High Point HRCav Rider.

12. High Point Stallion, Gelding and Mare. Points to be calculated from all categories where points have been gained in a section class.

Hi Point Overall Stallion, Mare and Gelding.

Point Score Rules ASHLA Vic 2015.

A minimum of 5 entries in a section will be required for a winner and runner up award to be given. Those with less than 5 entries will receive acknowledgment of the achievement.

Entry Fee: \$10.00 per horse to cover all sections.

PLEASE MAKE CHEQUES PAYABLE TO: ASHLA Vic.

All Sections will be scored equally:-	First Place	5 points
	Second Place	4 points
	Third Place	3 points
	Fourth Place	1 point

One (1) point for each place thereafter - where a ribbon has been awarded.

Supreme Champion	7 points
Champion	6 points
Reserve Champion	5 points

BONUS POINTS:- A bonus of **3 points** will be awarded if there award was gained at an ASH Branch Show. If placings are gained at a Royal Show, ASH Nationals (World Championships), or ASH State Championships in the respective disciplines, a bonus of **5 points** will be awarded.

In the event of a tie, a count back will take place giving awards gained in ASH classes' preference.

1. All saddle performances must be attained in classes open to ALL BREEDS or those classes restricted to registered ASH only. Led class points gained from these events in any category.
2. HRCV CLASSES must send a copy of their performance card. All points in this section are only eligible in this section and no other section as this is a restricted section and is not eligible for the overall high point section.
3. Riders classes, horsemanship events, progeny/owner groups, team/pairs are not eligible to gain points.
4. In the event of a horse attaining and equal or divided placing in an event the points pertaining to the highest place will be awarded.
5. Only performance attained in the period from the 1st January, 2015 to the 31st of December, 2015 in competition year are to be accepted.
6. To be eligible to gain points the member must be the actual competitor.
7. In the event of a member having two or more horses in a final or championship, then a substitute rider of leader may be appointed for one or more horses is applicable.
8. There is no limit to the number of horses a member may enter in a competition, but each horse with the member will be pointed as a single combination.
9. Horses need not necessarily be owned by the member.
10. Competitors are allowed one mount in the ASHLA event, ASH and Lady Rider.
11. Points for new members are valid from the date of joining.
12. Performance sheet will be rejected if illegible.
13. The onus is on the member to get their performance sheets in on time. Late sheets will **NOT** be accepted.
14. Each category must be submitted on a separate sheet to be valid.
15. Any competitor submitting false points will be disqualified. Random checks will be made.
16. No points will be accepted from events held on the dates of the National ASHLA Annual General Meeting.
17. All winners and runner ups will be notified as soon as possible following the competition.
18. There must be a minimum of 5 competitors in a category for a winner & runner up to be given.
19. Entry fee is \$10.00 per horse covering all section. No payment - No entry.
